

Some transparency in the obscurity

It is hard to see in the dark, but transparency obligations enable artists to see through the use and abuse of their works, and people to discern Al from the unique human artistry.



The importance of prior consent

Al thrives on the works created by artists without their consent.

Al-generated art would not exist without the work of real artists.

Prior consent and remuneration for the use of works and their derivates is vital.



Strike the (fundamental) right balance

Copyright is a fundamental right to property enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. Any use of a work without prior consent of the author or without compensation is a violation of the fundamental right to property.



Stop the free use

Every time a work is used for free, an artist misses an income opportunity. Existing exceptions to copyright for Text and Data mining should not extend to AI uses wether such uses are commercial or not.
